Treasurer’s Report (December): YTD Revenue--\$779,079; Expenses--\$656,407.

Trustees: Shrubbery has been removed; a committee is reviewing plans for painting the interior and exterior of the church; sanctuary lighting is being reviewed for possible improvement; cracked beams are being checked; examining enclosing outside tower to eliminate a pigeon problem.

Howard Johnson will serve in the position of Assistant Treasurer (replacing Larry Kuppler).

The 25th Anniversary celebration will be April 3 at the R.H. Johnson Social Hall. Pastor Steve Kappler will preach the sermon on that date.

66 Also...regarding communion...if the host is dropped, it is preferable that we pick it up
67 and eat it.

68 At the recession from a funeral, when there are remains of the deceased up front, the
69 remains go out first, followed by the family.


70 Discussion on pros and cons of allowing a eulogy at a funeral service. While it offers the
71 family an opportunity for memories, the eulogy can be too long, inappropriate for a
72 church service, or given by someone who is overcome with stage fright or uncontrolled
73 sobbing. Pastor Phill offers a choice to the family of a eulogy in the service or later, in
74 the Parish Hall, and he cautions the family on timing and appropriateness. Several
75 elders mentioned some discomfort with allowing a eulogy in the church service.

76 Vicar Gary announced that he will be sending each elder an e-mail asking us to respond
77 to the question, "Why don't many Lutherans serve in public office?" Our input will assist
78 him on an assignment for one of his current seminary courses.

80 The next Elders Meeting is scheduled for March 1, 2011 at 8:30 am. Chuck Wasem will have
81 the closing prayer. Chairman Ron Pearson asked that we discuss at the March meeting
82 President Obama's comment in his State of the Union address, "No one will be prevented from
83 serving the country they love because of who they love"...a reference to repeal of the 'don't ask;
84 don't tell' law.

86 The meeting was adjourned with prayer by Mike Dill at 10:15 am.
