Hebrews 12:1-3 "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before Him He endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider Him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart."

The sports world is keenly aware of the importance of having a full stadium of loyal fans cheering-on their team. One professional team puts great pride in their fans calling them the 12th man. In the heat of the game, when the athletes are tired, exhausted, and virtually unable to go any further, the roar of the crowd can make the difference between defeat and victory.
